GUIDELINES FOR FIRST-TIME SPEAKERS

Thank you for your interest in being a first-time speaker at Wound Care Today 2026.

Entry criteria include:

- Never spoken at a national conference before
- Submissions must be based on work carried out by yourself within your organisation.

The deadline to submit an entry for your chance to be selected as one of the first-time speakers at Wound Care Today 2026 is Wednesday 21st January 2026.

Your abstract should be a maximum of 350 words (including full name, job title, address, including postcode, daytime telephone number and email address).

Categories include:

- **Innovations in practice** — examples of collaborative working alongside patients for improving outcomes. Wound Care Today are particularly interested in case studies with a focus on overcoming barriers to health and wellbeing across populations
- **Quality improvement and service development** — focused approaches to challenge the system, reduce variants in practice, and promote patient-centred care
- **Clinical case reports** — share your experiences
